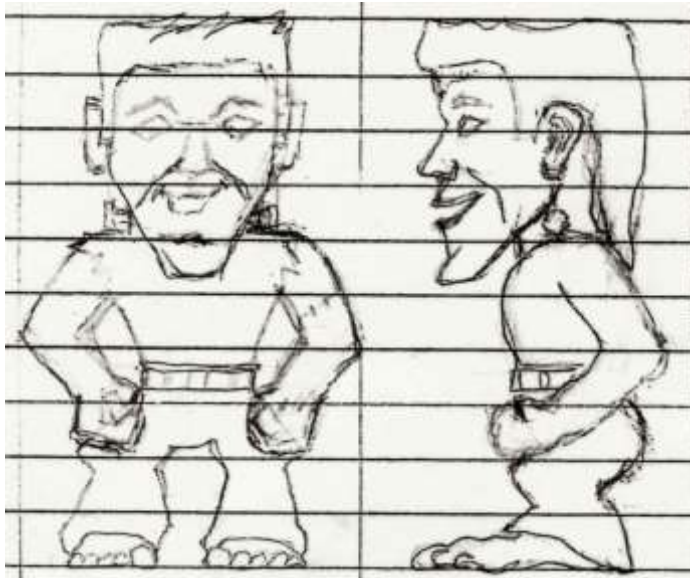
CHANCE TO SHOWCASE WHAT WE DO

SCRIBBLES.

As stated earlier, I do not draw, I scribble. With that in mind, I am including one of my scribbles here. One of my goals for 2013 is to start doing my own designs. With Halloween coming up what could be more fitting than to carve a Frank-n-Billy?

The scribble was sized to be done on the end of a 1 1/2" X 1 1/2" basswood stick. At that size the face view and profile can be cut out with a scroll saw.



The following are pictures of the cutout as well as a finished carving.



Please feel free to carve this scribble and let me know if you have a scribble you would like to share or if you have an idea you would like to see as a scribble.
