
Floyd Rhadigan has offered to have a carving seminar following the 2013 show. Several of us attended Floyd's seminar this year and can highly recommend attending if you can.

# SCRIBBLES:

I have to establish one fact up front. I do not draw, I scribble. With that in mind, I am including one of my scribbles here. One of my goals for 2013 is to start doing my own designs. Since I scribbled this little guy on the back of the bulletin Sunday (I was listening to the sermon honest!) I figured he was a good place to start.



The scribble was sized to be done on the end of a 1 1/2" X 1 1/2" basswood stick. At that size the face view and profile can be cut out with a scroll saw.

The following are pictures of the cutout as well as a finished carving.
