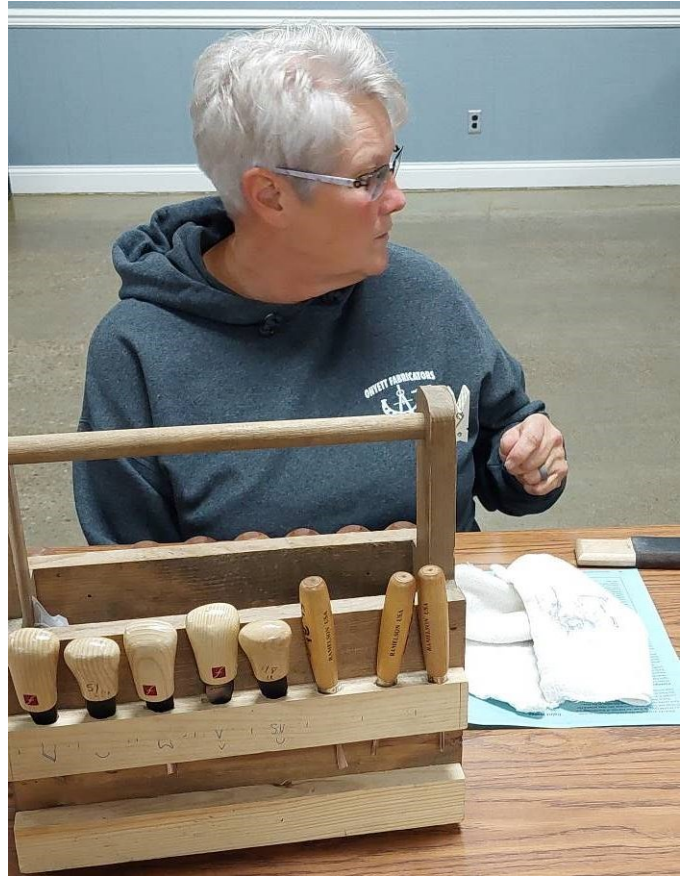
OPPORTUNITY KNOCKS:
