The session will start at 6:00 pm and last for about 90 minutes. Weather permitting the session will be held outside. The project will be carving a turtle from Ivory soap. Robin has picked up a couple dozen bars of Ivory soap for us to use during the session. We have 20 cookie sheets to use to carve the soap on. We passed out a half dozen carving tool kits to volunteer carving training assistants (club members) for use in their practice. We should have another 26 tool kits ready by our next club meeting. 20 kits for students and 6 kits, hopefully, for additional volunteer carving training assistants.
